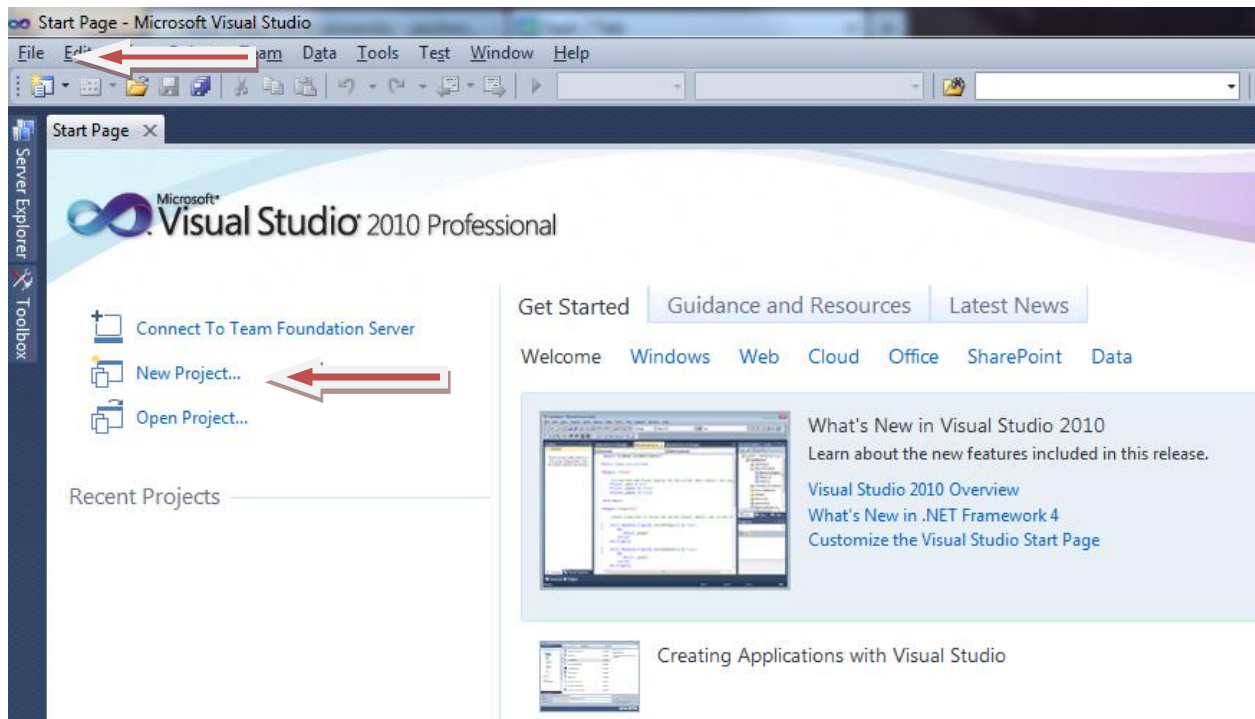


Microsoft Visual Studio– Making a New C# Project.

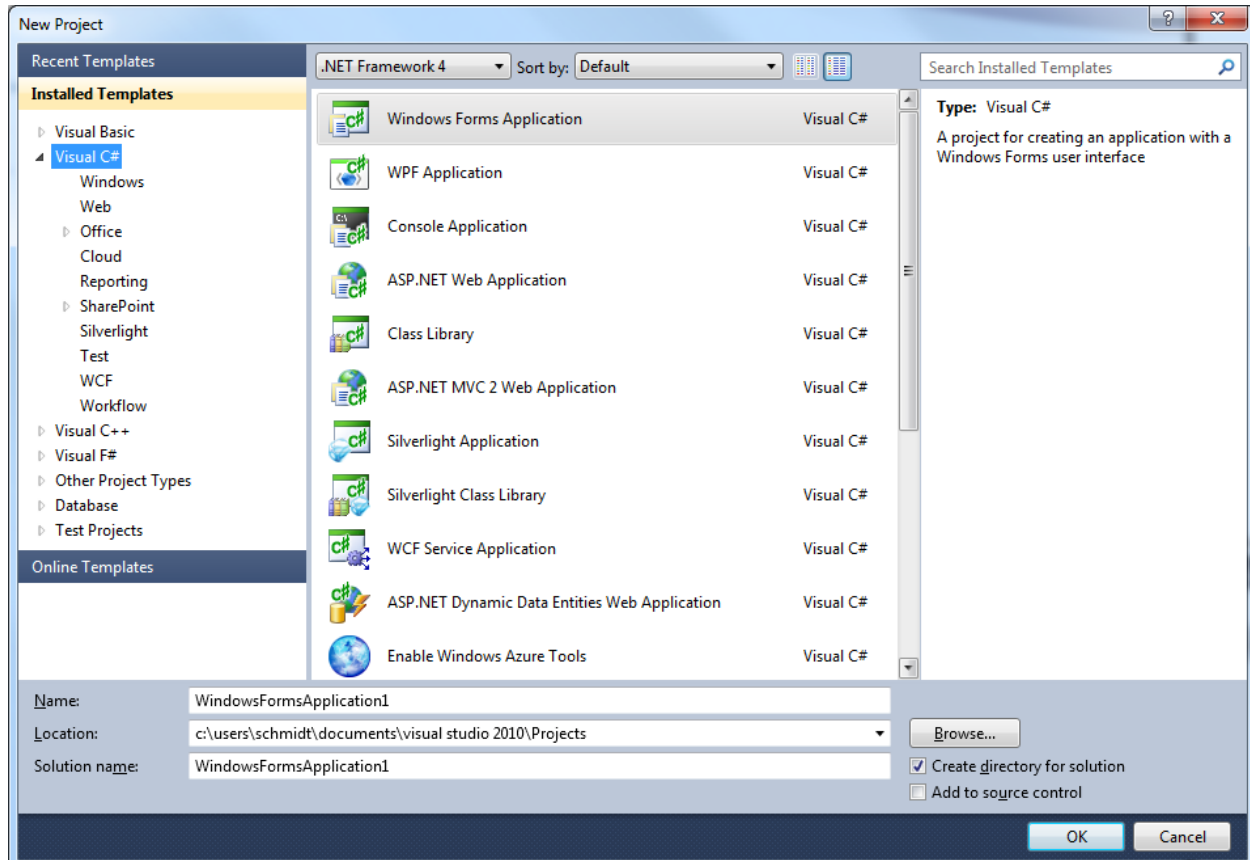
Step 1: The Start Page.

- When you start Visual Studio, this is the usual screen you will see.
- You can start a new project by either clicking “New Project” on the start screen or by clicking “File”-> “New”-> “ Project”.



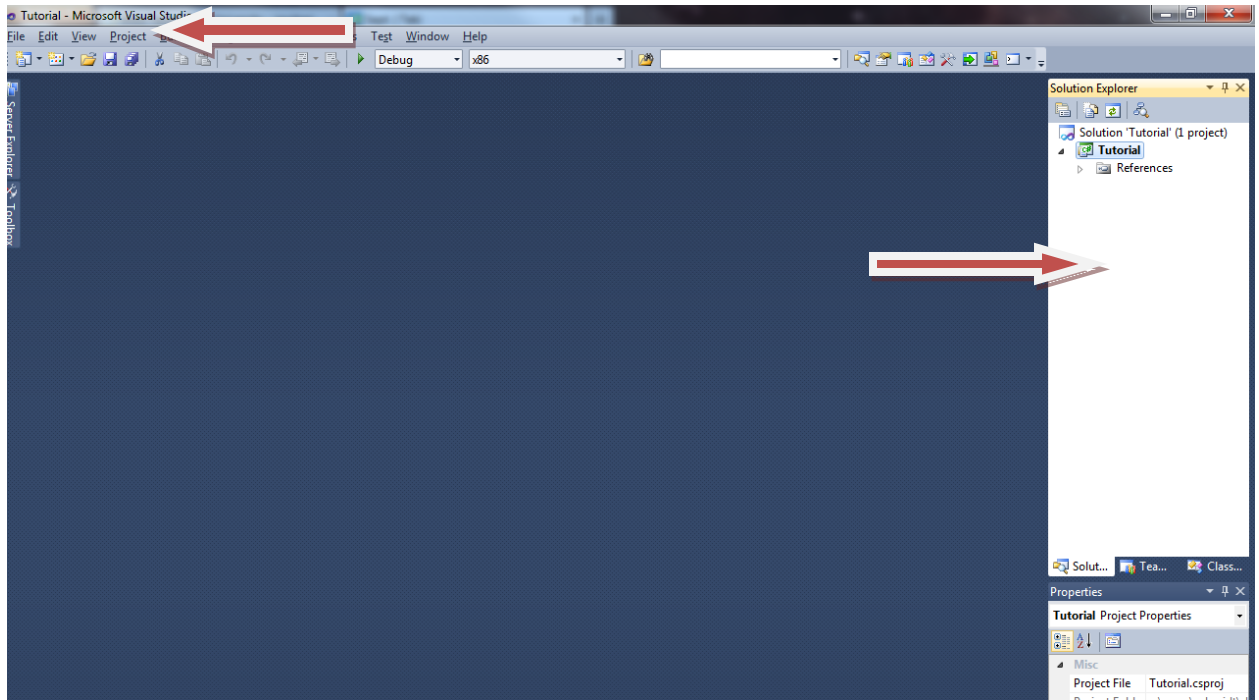
Step 2: New Project Window

- When the New Project Window comes up there will be language options. We will choose C#.
- Click the type of project you are looking for and rename the project something relevant. We chose “empty project”
- If you are using a lab or classroom computer you will want to change location. You can do this by clicking “Browse...” and selecting the desired location of the file (i.e. a portable storage device).
- Click “OK”.



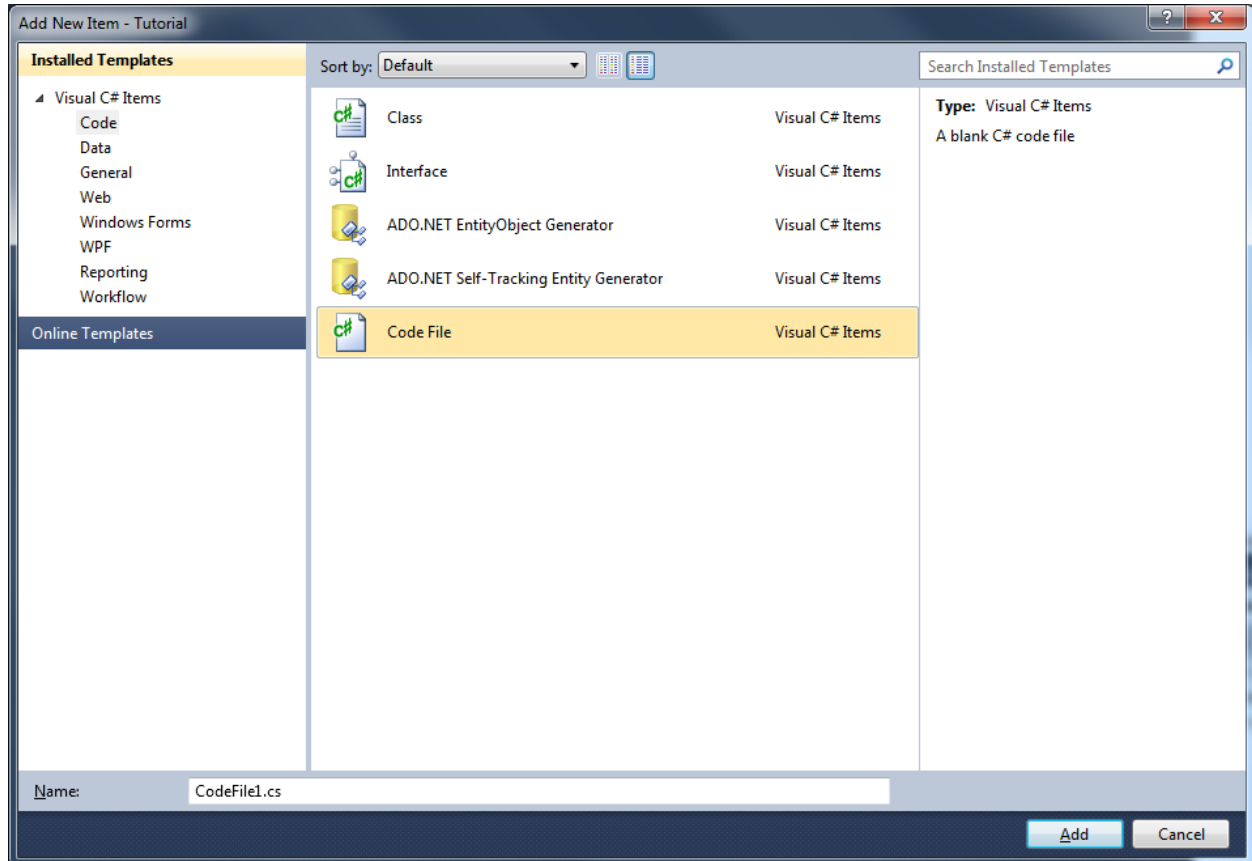
Step 3: New Item

- Now that you have a new project you will need to add content to it.
- Right click in the solution explorer and following “Add” -> “New Item” Or clicking “Project” -> “Add New Item” will bring you to the “New Item” menu



Step 3 Continued.

- For this menu you can add the new item type you are looking for.
- We selected “Code File” for our C# Project.



You're done!

You now have a new C# file that you can program in.
